## 5. Discussion Items

- 5.1. Safety (Jon) James will start tracking data about lab performance in regards to safety for the college safety committee using Gator TRACS. College safety committee is also putting together an onboarding safety tutorial for new faculty. Reminder that resumption to research forms need to get submitted to Christine.
- 5.2. Diversity and Inclusion (Ayse) The department Diversity and Inclusion student committee has changed their name to IDEA to match the college (Inclusion Diversity Equity and Access IDEA). Amplifying black voices issue of BME magazine came out just recently. Black history is February, IDEA is working on related activities. Please forward ideas for them. Grad students have raised issue of international students having pay disparities and may not be willing to raise concerns.   - 5.4.2. Faculty Vote Erica Moore: Request to promote from Affiliate to Affiliate with Graduate Faculty Status (Cherie) Faculty vote unanimously to approve.

  - 5.5.1. Minimum GA stipend & graduate student recruiting (Ben) Ben provided an update on BME online recruiting event and reminded faculty we need to direct recruit this year.



Christine informed faculty some funds will be provided by the graduate school that will go towards grad students coming in for new faculty. Ben provided an overview of stipend levels at other universities. He recommended we make a minimum Ph.D. student stipend at \$30k. Faculty voted in favor of raising the stipend to \$30k.

5.5.2. COVID Concern Reporting on GATORSAFE (Ayse) Ayse brought to faculty attention the new student report mechanism to let administration know if instructors are not teaching in person. Discussion ensued. Faculty wanted more information about where the information was going and how the administration will act on it.
