Membership Requirements: Supervisory Committees are designated by the student and faculty advisor. The Supervisory Committee for a candidate for the doctoral degree shall consist of no fewer than 4 members. ***All faculty must be members of the UF Graduate Faculty to be eligible.*** Additional requirements regarding the make-up of the committee are:

- at least 2 members, including the chair, must be from the BME Graduate Faculty, whereby **at least 1 of these is a Primary BME Faculty member.**
- at least 1 member from a different educational discipline, unaffiliated with the Department of BME (designed as the External Member)

Note, the Doctoral Advisor (Chair) must have Graduate Faculty status within the Department of Biomedical Engineering. If the desired research advisor is not a member of the BME Graduate Faculty (but is a member of the UF Graduate Faculty), they can only serve as the Co-Chair of the student and a faculty who is a member of Primary BME Graduate Faculty must be named as the Chair of the student's committee.
